Refunds

- **Studio Access Fees:** Are not refundable
- **Fee For Service / Tuition fee Refunds:** a full refund of paid tuition fees will be issued when course withdrawal is **more** than 28 days before the course commencement,
- **Funded Course Refunds** - A refund of any payments contributing to the student course tuition fee is available up to 4 weeks following the course commencement date. – refer to student handbook

Understanding the Fee Schedule

***Tuition Fee:** Students must meet all eligibility criteria in order to receive government funding. The student tuition fee is the amount the student pays upfront prior to commence the course. Students who have a current concession card such as a Health Care card are eligible to receive a 'concession' discount. Concession discounts are not available at Diploma or higher qualifications. There may be other costs associated with courses such as art kits, textbooks, software or equipment – these fees are additional to the tuition fee.

***Full Fee for Service:** is the total payable amount for students are not eligible for state based funding

****Studio Access Fee:** All courses have a studio access fee that is additional to the tuition fee that entitles them to studio access throughout their course duration.

*****VET Student Loans:** This is the amount students can defer to VET Student Loans. VET Student Loans is a student loan issued by the Australian Commonwealth Government aimed at making higher education more accessible by removing the financial barrier of paying upfront tuition fees.
